### Lew Barnes Summit Manufacturing



When Premier Community Bank client, Lew Barnes, drove into the bank parking lot in his 2019 cherry red Corvette modified with a Hennessey 1000 HP upgrade, it was more than the make and sounds of the car that caught the staff's attention.

Lew, a US Marine combat veteran who served in Vietnam in 1968 and 1969 as a crew chief/gunner on a UH-34 helicopter, commissioned Mike Lavallee (Killer Paint), an air brush artist, to depict scenes from his time in Vietnam. The custom paint job is a backdrop recognizing the ultimate sacrifice paid by 33 Marines of HMM-362—"The Ugly Angels" squadron—and one Marine from 2nd Btl. 3rd Marines (2/3), whose names, rank and KIA date are acid etched in the glass on the back hatch. Lew's mission is to bring attention to these warriors who died for the citizens of Vietnam.

### *What is going to change?*

You will see the same friendly faces when visiting a branch. You will notice an increase in products and an increase in our ability to service your needs—particularly in the areas of lending and wealth management. Together we will be over \$5 billion in assets, which will allow us to make larger loans. In addition, you will have access to Heritage's 59 branches in Washington and their existing branch in downtown Portland, Oregon.

### *How will my accounts change?*

You will begin to receive correspondence regarding your accounts in late summer/early fall of this year. Lew who owns and operates Summit Manufacturing has spent his lifetime commemorating fallen Marines through his work with "The Ugly Angel Memorial Foundation" and sharing his love for the Marines and the men and women who give their lives to serve our country.

Lew had the idea for the car when he saw how people are attracted to fast shiny cars and thought it would be a great way to remind communities about the lives lost in battle for our freedoms. Lew displays the car at military and other community events so that his Marines are remembered.

While you may see this one-of-a-kind car out and about, Lew has committed to donating it to the National Museum of the Marine Corps in Quantico, VA to be displayed beneath a UH-34 helicopter which at one time was in his squadron in Vietnam.

You will not find a more patriotic man than Lew Barnes. He would be the first to say that this story is not about him but rather the real heroes who lost their lives and did not make it home to enjoy the freedoms we experience today.
